Section B – Pilotage Charges

A charge calculated in accordance with the scale below is payable for the piloting of a vessel inwards or outwards the Pilotage District to or from either an anchorage, buoy or berth and for each piloted movement within the harbour. Pilotage rates apply for movements of up to 4 hours, beyond which, additional charges apply

Fresh Water = £2.78 per metric tonne

Gangways

Large Gangways (10m & 13m)

Hire = £1000 per Gangway (includes rig and remove for port stay)

- N.B Additional moves out-with arrival or departure will be an additional charge of £150

Small Gangway (7m)

Hire = £250

- Rig & Remove Charge = F.O.C.

Standard Security

Supply Base Piers (0700 – 1800) = £1485

Saltburn Pier (0700 – 1800) = £825
