We are looking for an experienced Chartered Engineer to join our team on a full-time basis. Reporting to the Operations Manager, the successful candidate will oversee port infrastructure projects and manage maintenance to ensure optimal use of PoCF facilities.

Key responsibilities:

- Multi-million £ Capital infrastructure development projects
- Project Management and budget management of multidiscipline projects (civil/electrical/water/fuel)
- Develop the maintenance plan, ensuring PoCF quays, piers, warehouses and lay down areas remain fit for purpose, clear of debris and safe to use. Include setting and monitoring KPIs and targets in line with that plan and to meet service level agreements
- Work collaboratively with customers and internal parties to ensure all assets are maintained to the appropriate standard of repair, safety and reliability.
- Review and optioneering of physical infrastructure layout and upgrades
- Capex and opex budget setting and control
- Project Management of multi – disciplined projects. Engineering/Construction/Maintenance
- Participate in funding activities for Capital Projects
- Attending Port business development and project meetings
- Negotiating contractor tenders and managing third party contractors
- Day-to-day management of the maintenance team, to deliver safe, efficient and effective maintenance operations of Port facilities.
- Undertake the implementation of planned maintenance programs with respect to operational and PLANT equipment as per maintenance/inspection schedules
- Supervision and control of equipment for the provision and reception of fuel oil, water and waste, including the processing of returns where required.
- To understand the tasks of Operation team and support deputise in the absence of Operations Manager.
- Support and promote the vision and values of the Port and lead on role modelling and reinforcing the required core values/behaviours
- Other duties as required from time to time in order to meet the needs of the business
